Pizza Rolls

Frozen Puff pastry

Your favorite pizza sauce

Pepperoni

Mushroom, diced

Capsicum, diced

Shredded cheese

Separate the pastry and spread a layer of pizza sauce over it. Add your desired toppings, then sprinkle cheese generously on top. Roll up the pastry, slice it into 2-centimeter pieces, and bake in the oven until golden brown. Allow the pastry to cool slightly before serving. Enjoy!
